GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES

- A. Entries will be accepted on **Thursday, August 25, 2016, from 8:00 a.m. - noon**, at the Fruit & Vegetable exhibit area of the fairground. Late entries will be displayed - if space is available - but not judged.
1. **Entries must be grown on Kauai by the exhibitor.**
 2. **Only one entry per variety of each commodity listed is allowed.**
 3. **Entries in Youth Division must be entirely grown by those 15 years old and younger.**
 4. **Entries must be properly entered.** Official entry forms will be available at the Fruit & Vegetable show area. Those with 10 or more items may pick up entry forms in advance at the UH-CTAHR Cooperative Extension Service, in the State Office Building, 3060 Eiwa Street, Room 210, Lihue (Phone: 274-3471).
- B. Judging will be by the Danish system; there may be more than one blue, red or white ribbon given for each commodity. Decisions of the judges are final. Judging will be based on Hawaii Grading Standards, when applicable, or by the following standards:
1. Uniformity in color, shape and size, characteristic of commodity.
 2. Free from defects, blemishes, injuries, insects or diseases.

OTHER ENTRIES:

All other fruit, vegetable or nut entries not listed above must be commonly used for human consumption, in quantities equal to 4 pieces or 1#, whichever is the greater amount.

All herb and spice entries must be those commonly used for human consumption. They must be bagged to 6 – 8 oz. These may include, but not limited to: arugula, basil, bay, cilantro, chiso, dill, fennel, garlic, kaffir leaves, lemongrass, marjoram, oregano, parsley, rosemary, sage, savory, tarragon, thyme.
